



Article Search Feature

Have you ever wanted to search for a particular article or reference and not known which publication or issue to find it in?

Now you can with **Zinio for Libraries Article Search**.

Zinio for Libraries —Article Search Database

What is the Article Search Database?

An add-on module for Zinio for Libraries collections, the Article Search Database searches magazines for specific topics and keywords.

What range of publications is included?

All 2016 publications forward, plus select backlist issues, are included in the search results.

How do I access the Article Search Database?

You need to be logged in to your library's collection site. If your library has the Article Search Database module, an Article Search link will appear next to the search window. Click on the link to access the database.

How do I search the Article Search Database?

After entering the Article Search Database, enter your search term into the search box. All articles with the search term in the article title, publication name or article content will appear in the search results.

How do I reach the article?

Click on the article and the full article—and, in most cases, all the graphics in the article—will open for full reading. Additional information about the publication, issue date, and the page that the article appears in the publication will also be displayed.

What if I want to read the article within the full issue?

Click on the **READ FULL ISSUE** tab to check out the full issue, and the publication will open for streaming in a separate Zinio Reader. Go to the page of the article and read the article. After the checkout is complete, you may also access the article in your mobile apps.

Why do I get a message that the article is not available when I click on the article link?

The message to try another article appears if your library collection does not contain the specific publication issue. Contact your information desk or your library's help desk to request that the issue be added back to the library collection, or select another article.

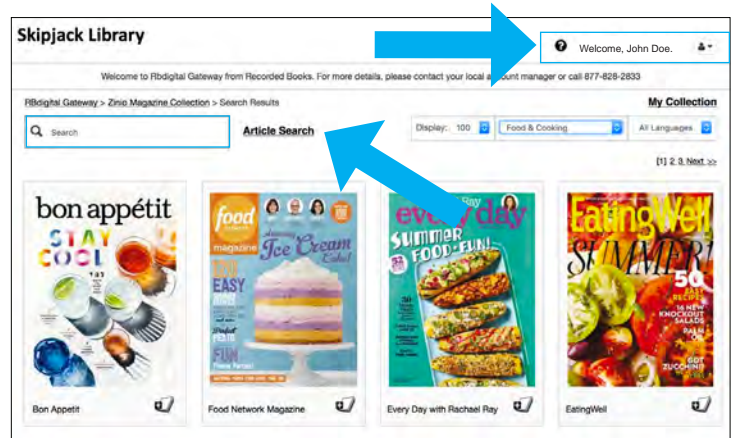
Can I use the Article Database from my mobile app?

Yes, but you need to first click on the **READ FULL ISSUE** tab to enter your library's collection site. You will see the Article Search link next to the Search box.

The following pages contain step-by-step instructions and screen samples.

Article Search appears after log-in.

- The Article Search Database opens in a new browser tab.
- The Article Search feature searches all 2016 publications forward, plus select back catalog issues beginning with your library collection's start date.
- Your search results will vary depending on what is in your library's collection.

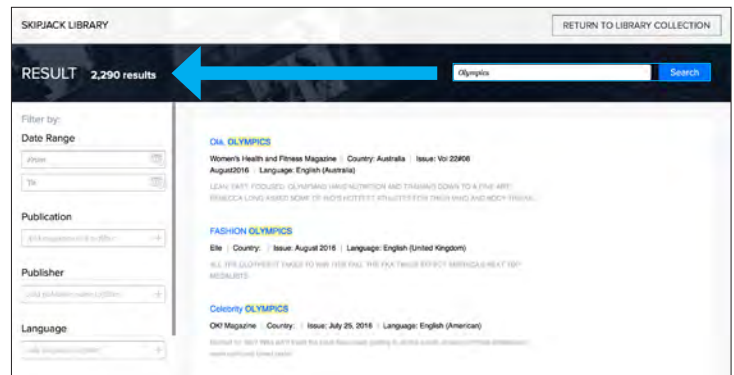


Article Search Result

1. **TYPE** in a search term (for example, "Olympics").



- a. "Olympics" search yields 2,290 results in this particular library's collection (your results may vary).
- b. Search looks first for the article title, then the article contents.
- c. Results are filtered by date, publication, publisher, language, and country.

The Summer Olympics, which begin Aug. 5 in Rio de Janeiro, will take place amid an economic recession, a presidential impeachment, rampant inner-city violence and a Zika virus epidemic. Yet the country is putting on a brave face, reflected in the Games' uplifting theme song, "Alma e Coração" ("Soul and Heart"), by samba star Thiaguinho with rapper Projota, produced by electronic duo Tropkillaz. 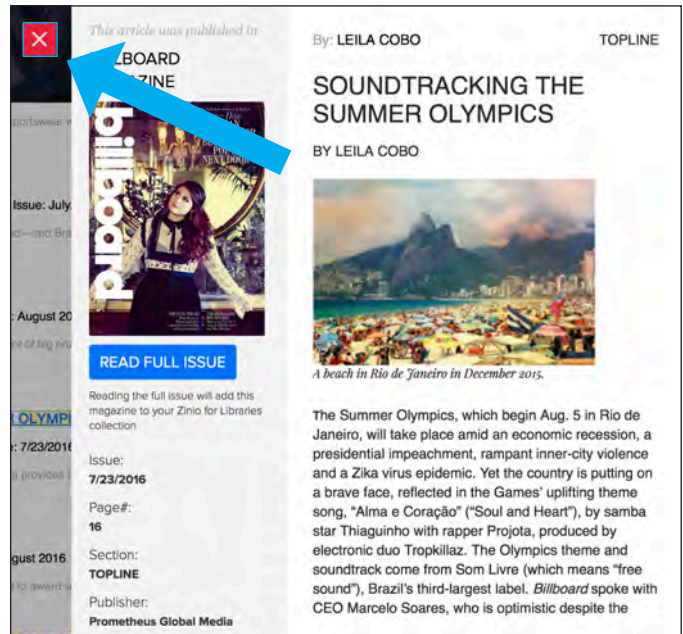
2. CLICK on article to open full article text and graphics.

READ FULL ISSUE

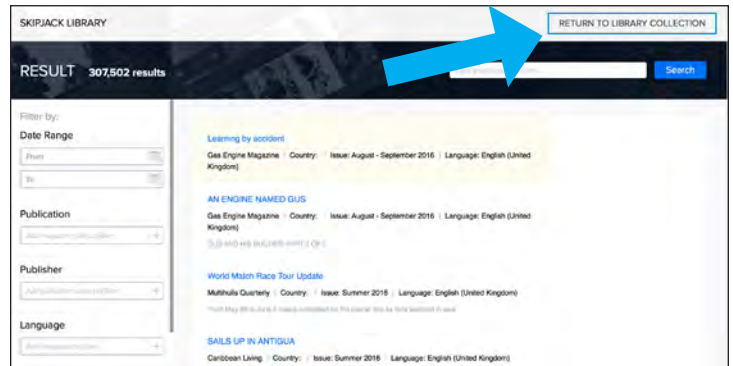
- a. Opening the article counts as an Article Search statistic recorded in Admin/Reports—and counts against issue checkout restrictions.
- b. Full Issue opens to the beginning of the issue.
- c. An article checkout is recorded to your account.



3. **SELECT**  to close the article.



4. **SELECT** RETURN TO LIBRARY COLLECTION or click on browser tab to return to your library's collection.



5. **SEARCH** or check out magazines as usual.
