Registration Policy for Children's Programs

Please honor our age designations. We design our programs for specific age groups and learning levels. We offer programs for specific ages as well as all ages. We select ages and learning levels so that children will get the most enjoyment based on their abilities. We understand there are siblings in different age ranges, but we offer programs for all ages.

- Your child must be age appropriate if an age or grade is specified for the program.
- Drop-In programs are for all ages.
- Movies are up to the parent's discretion. MPAA ratings are posted for all movies on our materials. For more information on the ratings you can visit:

- For Fall, Winter, and Spring Storytime Sessions: if your child is turning the appropriate age during the 4 or 6 week block they may register for that session. For Example, if your child is turning 3 during the session she/he may register for the 3 – 5 year olds group. If she/he is not 3 until after the session your child should register for 2 year olds. All registration for *storytime sessions* is in-person only. You can have a friend/neighbor/spouse sign your child up.
- Unless otherwise noted, registration is in-person only on the first day, after that you may register over the phone.
- A valid Matawan-Aberdeen Library card is required for program registration. If you do not have a library card please stop by the Circulation Desk and get one. It is FREE to residents of Aberdeen, Cliffwood, Cliffwood Beach, and Matawan. If you are not a resident, you may buy a card for \$10.00/year, which entitles you to register for programs. We are sorry, but Old Bridge patrons cannot purchase M.A.P.L cards just to register for programs.
- If registration is not required for a program, non-cardholders and Old Bridge residents can attend.
